SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Abstracts should not exceed 250 words.
- Full papers to be submitted should adhere strictly to the conference formatting guidelines as follows: English papers should be in Times New Roman, 12 font size and Arabic papers should be in Traditional Arabic, 18 font size. The title, Author(s), Institutional Affiliations, Mobile numbers and email address(s) of the author(s) should be clearly stated at the cover page. Full paper should not be more than 15 pages including Works Cited, 1.5-line space. Citation style for English papers should be in-text citation e.g. (Sulaiman 21) or Sulaiman (21) as the case may be with detail Works Cited at the end of the paper. For Arabic papers, Citation style should be footnoting. Conference proceedings shall be ready during the conference. Abstract should be submitted to: abstractissconference@nsuk.edu.ng and fullpaper should be submitted to: fullpaperissconference@nsuk.edu.ng
